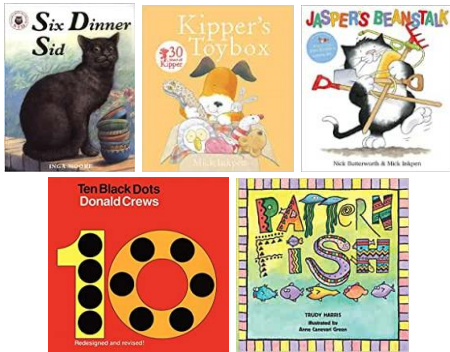


Mathematics – White Rose

‘Building 9&10’ - Representing numbers to 9, 10, composition of 9,10; comparing numbers to 10; number bonds to 10; 3D shapes; pattern
