

I wonder what our favourite books are?


- Weekly 'Book Banter' sessions where children have the chance to share their favourite stories. Look out for new themed sessions this term. ♥

- Children will create a wanted poster for their own perfect pet.


Key Skills to be Covered:

- David Attenborough: a modern day explorer.




Year 1 Term 4 'Animals'

I wonder what Cubism art looks like?


The children will learn about Pablo Picasso and Cubism art. They will create their own Cubism inspired animal print, using bold colours, shapes and lines.

- Meet the pet day!




Fabulous Finish
