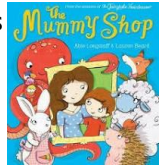
Literacy/Phonics

- Speech and language assessments



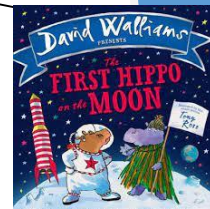
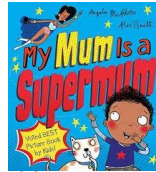
Communication and Language

- Letters to the aliens



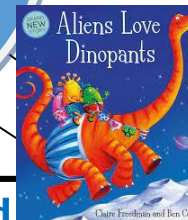

- Nature rainbows



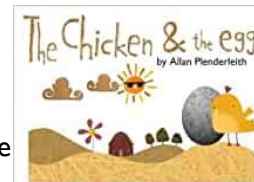
Sparkling Start – Celebrating International Women's Day by learning about important women in history!
