

Mathematics -

White Rose

Multiplication and Division:

- Children will recall their knowledge of counting in 2s, 5s and 10s and apply this to their learning of multiplication.
- Children will explore doubling and make equal groups as they begin to think about division.

Fractions:

- Children will make and find halves and quarters of shapes.
- Children will then move on to finding fractions of numbers.

Reading

I wonder what my friends like to read?

- Continuation of 'Book Banter' where children have the chance to talk about and discuss their favourite stories and what they love to read.
- Guided reading unit based on 'Shrek'.



Science

What was a castle made from?

The children will learn about different materials and their properties. They will compare and group different materials based on their properties.



English

- The children will rewrite the story of the paper bag princess using their knowledge of adjectives.
- Using information children have learnt in history they will create their own castle poster with labelled diagram.

- Children will write their own dragon poem.

Key Skills to be Covered:

- Using adjectives to make our writing interesting.
- Further consolidation of sentence structure with a focus on making sentences longer.



PSHE

- The children will explore what traits they have that make them a good friend.
- They will think about what they would do if they had a friend who was sad.



History

- Children will explore the features of a castle and what they were used for.
- We will explore the different jobs people had in castles.
- Children will compare the differences between living in a castle and their home.





Children will use simple programming skills in order to direct their bee-bot.




MFL
