## PSED

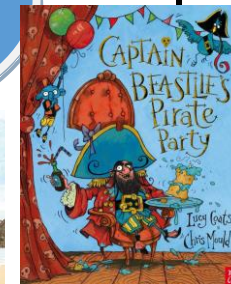
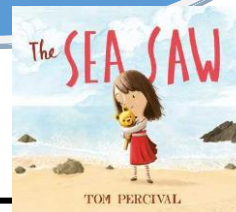
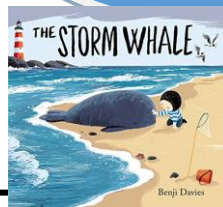
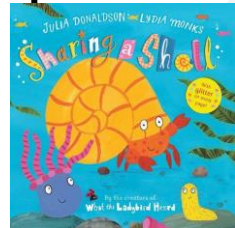
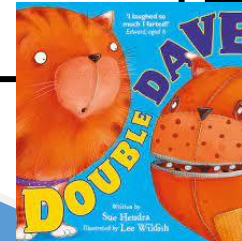
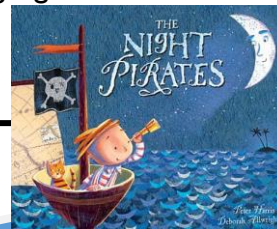
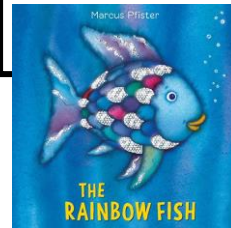
- All About Transition! We will explore the Year 1 playground and classrooms, visit the toilets and meet the teachers.
