Religious Education

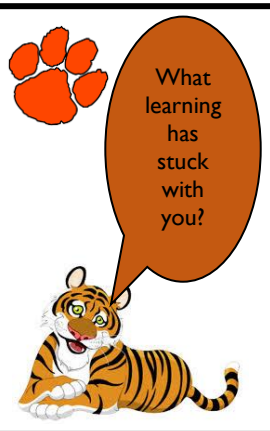
History and Geography focus in Term 3.

Children will describe the properties of different materials and compare and group together a variety of everyday objects on the basis of their properties.

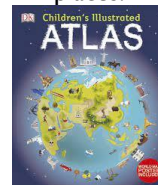
Year 1 Term 3 'Explorers'
