# Year 1 Learning Themes

Here is an overview of some of the things we will be doing at School:

## Phonics:

As you know, Phonics is a key part of our curriculum in Year 1. We work on sound recognition (knowing what sound letters and groups of letters make), blending skills (reading using sounds) and segmenting skills (sounding out to spell). We are also preparing for the phonics screening checks that will happen later this year.



## English:



We will be continuing our Letters and Sounds Phonics Programme by learning more of our Phase 5 sounds. We are practising writing 'complete sentences' whilst writing in a variety of different genres, including fact files, recounts and descriptive writing.

## Mathematics:

We will be continuing our number work whilst looking at weight, time and money. We plan a weekly problem-solving activity ensuring that children can apply their mathematical skills.

## Topics

**Explorers:** We will be exploring different places around the world, improving our knowledge of the continents and oceans!, as well as learning about Space. We will also be looking at some very important explorers such as Christopher Columbus and James Cook.

**Carnival of the Animals:** We will be researching many different animals, their habitats and comparing the climates they live in. We will also be learning about animals on the farm and where our food comes from.

## Supporting Your Child at Home

### Reading:

We encourage the children to continue reading as much as possible at home - it really does make a difference! Children can use a variety of skills such as phonics, pictures, knowledge of key words and comprehension in order to develop their reading.



### Rainbow Spellings:

Spellings are given out each week for children to learn and record in the green spelling books. Practise for '2 tries' and then that set can be swapped over. Spellings are collected in on Monday to be reviewed and given out on Wednesday. Please feel free to encourage your child to practise writing these words in sentences in their homework books so they really begin to apply the spellings when writing. A final spelling test will occur when a child has completed all 8 sets and gets them all correct.

### Homework:

We have really enjoyed seeing all the creative and innovative work that the children have completed from their homework wheels. Another homework wheel will be sent out for this next term based around our topic 'Explorers' with optional tasks to be completed each week.



We are continually revising our x2, x5 and x10. Your child can practise these on Timetables Rockstars.
