CAMP ON THE FIELD – FRIDAY 2ND JULY – SUNDAY 4TH JULY 2021

With the Year 6 Residential Trip fast approaching, I am writing to clarify the final arrangements.

On Friday, the children will leave school at their usual time. They should return to school with one holdall and make their way to the wooden gate which leads to the swimming pool, where Mr Rogers will be on hand to lead the children onto the field for the register to be taken. Please queue alongside the kitchen windows, ensuring you are socially distanced and adults are wearing face coverings. Parents and carers may drive onto the school site when dropping off and collecting their children.

Reminder – please note there should be no mobile phones or electronic devices taken to Camp on the Field.

Please note the following number should only be used in the event of a family emergency, outside of School hours, when it is imperative that a pupil is contacted. It should not be used as a means to keep in touch with pupils during the Camp on the Field.

Medication – If your child requires any medication during their stay, this needs to be handed into the school office **on Monday 28th June** in a named polythene bag stating your child's name with dosage instructions clearly marked on the box / bottle. **Please do not bring in any medication on Friday. Even if your child has an asthma pump in school, a spare will need to be provided for the weekend. This will also need to be brought into the school office on Monday with all the necessary instructions (as above).**

At this time of year, the weather forecast can be unpredictable so please pack appropriate clothing including a hat and sun cream, as per the packing list.

Please collect your child at 10am on Sunday. This promises to be an exciting adventure for the children, but please be prepared for a delay in hearing all about it as they will be exhausted afterwards!!

Please be advised, unless we are instructed otherwise by the Government and Local Authority, the Year 6 residential will be going ahead as planned.
