## **Terms 1 & 2 Extended Learning Clubs** **Monday 20<sup>th</sup> September – Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2021 3:15pm – 4:15pm**

As we start returning to normality, our Joy Lane staff will once again be providing a wide range of Extended Learning Clubs and in-school enrichment activities to broaden the learning experience of the children. The feedback from the children, parents and carers has always been very positive, and the most important thing is the children enjoy the extended school day and extra learning experiences we offer.

We will be offering a broad range of quality after school clubs for the children to sign up to; however, due to reduced funding for schools and increased costs, we will be charging a nominal £1 fee per session for the clubs. The exception being that if your child is in receipt of Free School Meals then the School Pupil Premium allocated will meet the cost of the clubs; you will still need to pay in advance and will be refunded afterwards. I am sure you will agree the extensive list of clubs attached provides excellent value for money.

During Terms 1 and 2, the clubs will run from Monday 20<sup>th</sup> September to Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> December (9 weeks). **Please note clubs will NOT be running the week commencing Monday 11<sup>th</sup> October when our Parent Partnership Meetings are being held.** Places will need to be booked and paid for in advance using ParentMail via the 'shop' icon. All Extended Learning clubs must adhere to the appropriate adult / child ratio and we, therefore, have to limit numbers accordingly.

You will be able to book on ParentMail from **Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> September until Friday 17<sup>th</sup> September 2021.**

**Please see attached a brief synopsis of the clubs, which includes details of where to collect your child at 4:15pm once the club has finished.**

Our staff are very kindly giving up their own time to provide the extra-curricular opportunities for your children and impeccable behaviour is expected at all times. All children who sign up for a club are expected to attend every session to comply with our Safeguarding procedures. If a child is unable to attend, you must inform the school office so the necessary amendment can be made to the club register.

**After the club has finished, all children will need to be collected by an authorised adult.**

**Years 5 & 6 Children – If you give permission for your child to walk / cycle home independently, please contact the school office for the necessary arrangements to be made.**
